The students who are studying X Class during the current academic year i.e., 2013-2014 in any recognized school in Andhra Pradesh including Kendriya Vidyalayas and schools affiliated to I.C.S.E. & C.B.S.E., New Delhi are only eligible to appear for the above said Examination. The candidates those who are selected for NTSE scholarships in VIII class are not eligible to appear for the Test. The students who have selected for NMMS scholarships and studying X class now may also eligible for NTS Examination but such candidates have to forego the further NMMS scholarships, if he/she are selected in NTS Examination.

The examination consists of Mental Ability Test for 50 marks, Language Comprehensive Test for 40 marks (Telugu/Urdu/English) and Aptitude Test for 90 marks comprising Social sciences, Sciences and Mathematics.
